Note

August Querfurt was an early 18th century hunting and battle scene painter following the trend of earlier 17th century painters such as Philips Wouberman and Pieter van Laer. He was born in Wolfenbüttel in 1696 and died in Vienna in 1761.

Authenticity

This work has been seen by dr. Birgit Schumacher, leading expert on paintings of Philips Wouberman (1619-1668), and deemed an original work by the hand of August Querfurt in his early period.
